Trekking Across Our Universe! Celebrate space travel and the solar system in this story time program.

Egg-stronaut Drop! Participants will create a capsule that will protect their egg-stronaut from a crash landing. The lightest capsule that successfully protects its egg will win.

Sun and Moon Yoga! Come learn about traditional yoga practices including movements and poses related to the sun and the moon. This will be a fun and relaxing introductory program for kids.

Robots Rove the Moon! An Ozobot and Sphero Program— participants will be challenged to map a route for their robot to travel around the surface of the moon.

Mad Science! Walking on the Moon: “Travel 238,900 miles above the earth as we commemorate the 50th anniversary of humans first landing on the moon. What's it like to travel in space? With the help of some volunteers, kids will learn what it's like to explore space and the space technology used on earth today.”

Escape Room! Kids will see if they can find the clues, solve the riddles, and unlock all of the locks before time runs out.

Trivia Night—Test your knowledge regarding a variety of science fiction-related books, films, video games, graphic novels and TV shows. There will be 5 rounds of 10 questions and the winning team will walk away with a prize. This is a free event!
